## A RESOLUTION FROM THE CITY OF CRAIG SUPPORTING THE CITY'S CAPITAL PROJECT PRIORITIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006

- WHEREAS, the City of Craig Wastewater Facilities Plan and Craig Water System Comprehensive Plan identify specific projects needed by Craig's wastewater collection and treatment and water distribution and treatment systems; and
- WHEREAS, the Craig Wastewater Facilities Plan has determined that the West Hamilton Pump must be upgraded, which requires replacement of the pump to handle the increased flows, and force main to redirect flows across the Cemetery Island Causeway to the city's wastewater treatment plant, the cost of which is estimated at \$432,000; and,
- WHEREAS, the Craig Water System Comprehensive Plan identifies as a required need the upgrade of water main lines into the community, and the recent discovery of a bread in one of two water mains serving Craig greatly amplifies the need to complete the water main upgrade project, the cost of which is estimated at \$493,000; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Craig City Council declares the West Hamilton Pump Station and force main project; and the Craig Water System Distribution Repair project as the two top State Capital Construction Projects for fiscal year 2006.
