RESOLUTION 04-24**

**A RESOLUTION NOMINATING THE PORT ST. NICHOLAS ROAD
UPGRADE PROJECT FOR CONTINUED INCLUSION IN THE
ALASKA STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Port St. Nicholas road is an important link from the Port St. Nicholas Subdivision and City of Craig services; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Craig uses the Port St. Nicholas road to regularly access municipal water storage, the municipal water treatment plant and the municipal water source; and,

WHEREAS, the original constructed logging road surface has degraded and is difficult to maintain; and,

WHEREAS, vertical and horizontal curves and sightlines are substandard and unsafe for the residential, commercial and industrial traffic the road now bears; and,


WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has committed \$3 million for survey, redesign and construction; and,

WHEREAS, a survey of the road has been completed and redesign is taking place using Bureau of Indian Affairs funds; and,

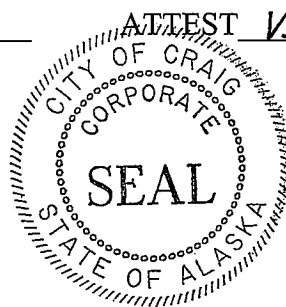
WHEREAS, the project has been on the State of Alaska State Transportation Improvement Plan since 2001, but has not been funded by the State of Alaska.


