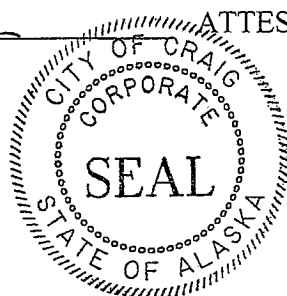
WHEREAS, the Craig City Council has identified certain capital improvement project priorities for the City of Craig for calendar year 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following projects, set forth in order of priority, are established as the City of Craig's top priorities for capital improvement projects for calendar year 2014:


