ADL 107799, City of Craig, Klawock Inlet, Outfall Line As-Built Survey Request for Proposals

The City of Craig leases city owned uplands and tidelands to Silver Bay Seafoods to operate a seafood processing plant. Associated with the operations of this plant is a processing waste disposal outfall. This outfall includes approximately 2,100 linear feet of 6" diameter HDPE outfall pipeline terminating at a depth of approximately -85 ft MLLW. The city requires an as-built survey of the marine outfall pipe and associated structures as outlined in the Alaska DNR/DMLW as-built survey instructions dated August 7, 2017. Contractors will be required to submit an estimated cost of the project, but it is the city's intent to negotiate a final cost with successful proposer based on the preliminary estimate of time and materials and any changes based on proposed addendums to the DNR/DMLW instructions.

The City of Craig is seeking a proposal to accomplish the following tasks:

1. As-Built Survey.

- a. Review ADNR/DMLW survey instructions prior to a pre-work meeting with the City of Craig for the purpose of making recommended corrections or changes to the instructions for consideration of DNR/DMLW per section A of the instructions.
- b. Act as the city's agent to negotiate addendums to the instructions based on review and meeting with the city.
- c. Complete an as-built survey as directed by DNR/DMLW instructions with addendums.

2. Deliverables.

 As-Built Survey. Contractor will provide all physical and electronic deliverables required by the DNR/DMLW instructions with addendums.

3. Payment Schedule.

- a. The contractor may submit invoices for payment on a monthly basis based on percentage of project completion. Monthly invoices shall be submitted on company letterhead or company invoice. The city reserves the right to withhold 10% of monthly invoice payments until final payment based on approval of all deliverables by DNR/DMLW.
- b. Complete final payment shall be made no later than 30 days after submittal of contract deliverables.

4. Timetable.

- a. Contractor will complete review of DNR/DMLW survey instructions and meet with the city for a pre-work meeting within thirty (30) days of award and signing of the contract.
- Contractor will complete all required research, fieldwork and submissions to DNR/DMLW within forty-five (45) days of receiving complete instructions and all addendums from DNR/DMLW.

5. City shall provide:

- a. Payment for all DNR/DMLW fees associated with the final instructions. Fees may be paid by the city or may be reimbursed to the contractor on a cost basis in addition to final negotiated fees for the work.
- b. Boat and operator (including fuel and equipment).

Proposals:

Contractors shall provide a complete proposal including the following items:

- 1. Estimated time and materials and total cost for items not provided by the city.
- 2. Fee schedule for all labor and material items necessary to complete the work.
- 3. Brief description of similar work completed by the contractor.
- Description of the method that the contractor proposes to use to complete the required survey, particularly completion of the underwater portion of the work required.

Please submit a complete proposal including all items required below. Proposals should be submitted on company letterhead and signed by a person authorized.
