This is in response to your January 6, 2016, application for a Department of the Army (DA) permit submitted on your behalf by Mr. Tracy Moore, to temporarily discharge 30 cubic yards of native material into 0.0138-acres of intertidal waters for the installation of a residential waste water outfall into a trench. Excavated material will be temporarily discharged immediately adjacent to the constructed trench. The trench will be up to 150 feet long by 2 feet wide. A 4-inch sewer outfall pipe will be placed within the trench and the excavated native material will be placed back into the trench. The trench will be constructed at low tide, when water is not present, and with machinery. No machinery will be operated within water. If the tide is not low enough to reach the -4 MLLW tidal level, hand tools will be used to complete the installation, by laying the pipe on the surface and anchoring with rocks. It has been assigned file number POA-2015-626, Port Saint Nicholas which should be referred to in all future correspondence with this office. The project site is located within Section 16, T. 74 S., R. 81 E., Copper River Meridian; USGS Quad Map Craig B-4; Latitude 55.4570° N., Longitude 133.1130° W.; Port Saint Nicholas No. 3 Subdivision, Lot 1, near Craig, Alaska.

Based on our review of the information you provided and available to our office we have preliminarily determined the subject project area contains waters of the U.S., and/or wetlands, under the Corps' regulatory jurisdiction. See the attached Preliminary Jurisdictional Determination (PJD) Form. Please sign and return the form to our office. A PJD is not appealable. At any time you have the right to request and obtain an Approved Jurisdictional Determination, which can be appealed. If it is your intent to request an Approved JD, do not begin work until one is obtained.

DA permit authorization is necessary because your project will involve work in and placement of structures and fill material into waters of the U.S. under our regulatory jurisdiction.

Based upon the information and plans you provided, we hereby verify that the work described above, which would be performed in accordance with the enclosed plan (sheets 1-3), dated January 11, 2016, is authorized by Nationwide Permit (NWP) No. 7, Outfall Structures and Associated Intake Structures. NWP No. 7 and its associated Regional and General Conditions can be accessed at our website at: www.poa.usace.army.mil/Missions/Regulatory/Permits.aspx. Regional Condition G applies to your project. You must comply with all terms and conditions associated with NWP No. 7.

Further, please note General Condition 30 requires that you submit a signed certification to us once any work and required mitigation are completed. Enclosed is the form for you to complete and return to us.

The Nationwide Permits are due to expire on March 18, 2017, unless the NWP is modified, reissued, or revoked. It is incumbent upon you to remain informed of changes to the NWPs. Nothing in this letter excuses you from compliance with other Federal, State, or local statutes, ordinances, or regulations.







EXPLANATION OF PRELIMINARY AND APPROVED JURISDICTIONAL DETERMINATIONS: 1. The Corps of Engineers believes that there may be jurisdictional waters of the United States on the subject site, and the permit applicant or other affected party who requested this preliminary JD is hereby advised of his or her option to request and obtain an approved jurisdictional determination (JD) for that site. Nevertheless, the permit applicant or other person who requested this preliminary JD has declined to exercise the option to obtain an approved ID in this instance and at this time. 2. In any circumstance where a permit applicant obtains an individual permit, or a Nationwide General Permit (NWP) or other general permit verification requiring "preconstruction notification" (PCN), or requests verification for a nonreporting NWP or other general permit, and the permit applicant has not requested an approved JD for the activity, the permit applicant is hereby made aware of the following: (1) the permit applicant has elected to seek a permit authorization based on a preliminary ID, which does not make an official determination of jurisdictional waters; (2) that the applicant has the option to request an approved ID before accepting the terms and conditions of the permit authorization, and that basing a permit authorization on an approved ID could possibly result in less compensatory mitigation being required or different special conditions; (3) that the applicant has the right to request an individual permit rather than accepting the terms and conditions of the NWP or other general permit authorization; (4) that the applicant can accept a permit authorization and thereby agree to comply with all the terms and conditions of that permit, including whatever mitigation requirements the Corps has determined to be necessary; (5) that undertaking any activity in reliance upon the subject permit authorization without requesting an approved JD constitutes the applicant's acceptance of the use of the preliminary JD, but that either form of JD will be processed as soon as is practicable; (6) accepting a permit authorization (e.g., signing a proffered individual permit) or undertaking any activity in reliance on any form of Corps permit authorization based on a preliminary JD constitutes agreement that all wetlands and other water bodies on the site affected in any way by that activity are jurisdictional waters of the United States, and precludes any challenge to such jurisdiction in any administrative or judicial compliance or enforcement action, or in any administrative appeal or in any Federal court; and (7) whether the applicant elects to use either an approved JD or a preliminary JD, that JD will be processed as soon as is practicable. Further, an approved JD, a proffered individual permit (and all terms and conditions contained therein), or individual permit denial can be administratively appealed pursuant to 33 C.F.R. Part 331, and that in any administrative appeal, jurisdictional issues can be raised (see 33 C.F.R. 331.5(a)(2)). If, during that administrative appeal, it becomes necessary to make an official determination whether CWA jurisdiction exists over a site, or to provide an official delineation of jurisdictional waters on the site, the Corps will provide an approved JD to accomplish that result, as soon as is practicable.


